

## Homeschool Support Program Policy

### **Policy:**

Beginning with the 2023/2024 school year, EFCA will offer families a la carte options for attendance. Given a set pricing model, homeschool families could enroll for up to 75% of the school day at the prorated tuition in the table below:

### **Collateral Options:**

- Bussing Options
  - Students attending a first or last period class could be offered bussing if they meet current bussing criteria. Parents are responsible for full or partial transportation.
- Enrollment limitations
  - In the event that an elementary class or secondary grade level enrollment reaches a maximum and waitlist needs to be created, EFCA will award preference for waitlisted seats to selected class/grade based to full-time students first and homeschool support students second.
- Elimination of other discounts
  - Since the tuition is already discounted, there would be no other discounts (early registration, full payment, transfer, outside church employee).
  - Full-time EFA/EFCA employees pay the discounted tuition regardless of number of enrolled classes.
